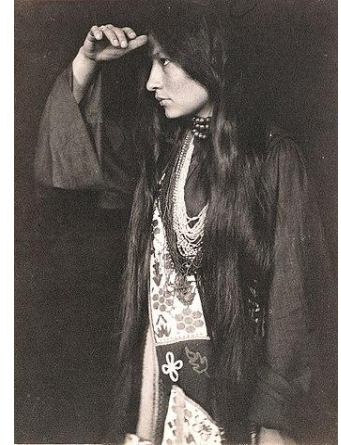


# Writing a Historical Dialogue
